CIV02 - ROME, BAROQUE TOUR

CULTURE AND HISTORY

Rome - one of the world's most iconic cities, steeped in history and rich in Italian charm - awaits you after an approx. 1.5-hour coach drive from Civitavecchia. A city guide will be on hand to meet you on arrival and then escort you on a Roman tour that includes external viewing of the Colosseum. You may also attend the Pope's weekly Angelus - held on St. Peter's Square every Sunday - giving you a chance to admire the splendid Bernini Column at the same time. You will have free time to explore on your own, to have lunch or to visit the Basilica - your guide will provide information on the site beforehand. The excursion ends with a walk to the Pantheon and the lovely Piazza Navona. After saying goodbye to your guide, you will return to the port. Please note: Lunch is not included in the price of the excursion and is at the clients' charge. The "Angelus" takes place only on Sunday and depends on the Vatican's programmes. Have the possibility of attending it reconfirmed during your cruise. St. Peter's Basilica may close with very short notice for reasons beyond MSC's control (Vatican's programmes); have the opportunity to visit it during your free time reconfirmed during your cruise. There may be long queues to enter St. Peter's Basilica. Conservative attire recommended for visiting sites of religious importance. It may be dusk on autumn and winter calls while visiting some of the sites. Guests using a wheelchair can take part, but they must be advised that the excursion includes a long walking tour and that they must be accompanied by a paying helper to provide assistance with getting on and off the coach and that wheelchairs must be collapsible/foldable since the coach has neither a ramp nor a lift. Guests using a wheelchair who would like to participate in this tour are requested to contact the Shore Excursions' Desk promptly once they are on board so that arrangements can be made.

CIV03 - ROME ON YOUR OWN

This unguided tour of Rome begins with an approx. 1.5-hour drive by coach, after which you can spend the entire day exploring "The Eternal City" the capital of Italy at your leisure. You will receive instructions on how best to get around town and a map showing the main sights and monuments. Some of the must-sees Rome is known for include the Colosseum and the Roman Forum, the Pantheon, the beautiful Piazza Navona in old Rome and the neighbouring Vatican City State in Rome's modern centre, to name but a few. As one of the world's fashion capitals, the city is also choc-full of superb shopping facilities. Further sights include the magnificent Bernini Column on St. Peter's Square, which is also the site of the Pope's Sunday Angelus. Please note: the bus stops near "Piazza del Popolo"; this is the point of arrival and departure of your tour. Wheelchair users must be accompanied by a paying helper to provide assistance with getting on and off the coach; wheelchairs must be collapsible/foldable since the coach has neither a ramp nor a lift. Leave the port for a 1.5-hour drive to Italy's capital city and experience one of the most comfortable ways to visit Rome with a sightseeing coach tour of all the attractions that make up this "Eternal City". Next, after boarding your coach again, you will drive to Tarquinia, one of the 12 Etruscan cities in the past. Your guide will take you on an interesting itinerary to discover of this important village in the heart of Tuscia territory. CULTURE AND HISTORY



This excursion combines two of the most important aspects of Rome: Christianity and antiquity. Bus transfer to Rome (1.5 hours) to meet our guide and start the tour with a visit to the Colosseum, also known as the Flavian Amphitheatre. We will look around this impressive edifice, built to hold up to 50.000 people and where the Romans used to watch the cruel gladiators combats. The tour continues with a stroll around Trevi Fountain, Piazza Navona and the Pantheon, an ancient temple built in honour of seven important Roman deities. Stop for lunch in a typical Italian restaurant. The afternoon will be for the home of Christianity as we pay a visit to St. Peter's Square: free time to explore the square or to visit the Basilica independently after receiving information from the guide outside the site. After leaving our guide in Rome, we will return to the port. Please note: the tour is not recommended for guests with walking difficulties. St. Peter's Basilica and the Colosseum have ramps for wheelchair users. Wheelchair users can take part in this tour, but they must be aware that it is almost entirely on foot. They must be accompanied by a paying helper to provide assistance with getting on and off the coach; wheelchairs must be collapsible/foldable since the coach has neither a ramp nor a lift. Wheelchair users wishing to take part in this are requested to contact the Shore Excursions' Desk promptly once they are on board so that arrangements can be made. It may be dusk on autumn and winter calls while visiting some of the sites. Conservative attire recommended for visiting sites of religious importance. The restaurant lunch may be earlier or later depending on the day of call. St. Peter's Basilica may close with very short notice for reasons beyond MSC's control (Vatican's programmes); have the opportunity to visit it during your free time reconfirmed during your cruise. There may be long queues to enter St. Peter's Basilica. This tour is not available on the first Sunday of every month.

Sunday 18 May 2025**MYK04 - DELOS: THE ISLAND OF GREEK MYTHOLOGY**

CULTURE AND HISTORY

Situated in the middle of the Cyclades Group lies Delos, the "Island of Light, and the destination of this enjoyable tour. After a short boat trip, your exploration of Delos' historical remains and rich mythology can begin. Legend has it that Zeus took a shine to the beautiful Leto, in the course of which affair she fell pregnant. However, this drew the ire of Zeus' wife, Hera, who promptly forbade Mother Earth to give Leto refuge. Just when all hope seemed to be lost, a serendipitous island Delos rose out of the sea, giving Leto a safe haven to deliver twins Artemis and Apollo. Popular as a pilgrimage site among ancient Grecians, Delos became one of the wealthiest shrines of antiquity. Among the remains of this era is the Avenue of Lions, so named for a row of originally 7th-century Naxian-marble lions that seem to guard the spot where Leto is said to have given birth. You can then crown your exceptional experience by taking the path up to Mount Cynthos, from whose peak Zeus is said to have watched the birth of his twins. Do not let the uphill hike deter you, for the mind-blowing view from the peak is worth every step. Round out your visit by exploring some of the numerous other monuments at the site before beginning your return journey to your port. Please note: this tour includes approximately 1.5 hours of walking, at times over uneven surfaces. The tour is not available to guests who use a wheelchair; guests of limited mobility are requested to evaluate their personal level of stamina and ability before taking part.

Venture out and uncover the many different facets of Mykonos island, the "St. Tropez of Greece". Just how much the island has to offer is yours to discover on this relaxing and mainly coach-based tour, which begins with a drive to the so-called Panorama vantage point. A photo stop will give you a chance to capture beguiling views of Mykonos town and the old port, before a scenic route will take you through the picturesque villages of Agios Ioannis and Kalafatis as well as past the cosmopolitan beach of Ornos. A stop will be made at the heart of Mykonos to visit the island's second-largest settlement, the village of Ano Mera, at whose centre stands the monastery and church of Panagia Tourliani. Probably founded at some time during the 16th-century and then remodelled in 1767, the cloister is a major draw for travellers visiting the area. A generous helping of warm Greek hospitality then awaits you in a village taverna, giving you a chance to reflect on your day of Mykonian magic as you relax to the aniseed flavour of ouzo and the savoury goodness of typical Greek appetizers. More pleasing views can then be enjoyed during the return drive to the port and your ship. Please note: this tour is not available to guests who use a wheelchair; guests of limited mobility are requested to evaluate their personal level of stamina and ability before taking part. Conservative attire recommended for visiting sites of religious importance. The tour may have multiple departures during the day. Once on board, please contact the Shore Excursions' Desk for information about the precise departure time.

Next to an amazing nightlife, cosmopolitan atmosphere and beautiful landscape, Mykonos is also home to a slew of gorgeous beaches, some of which you will be discovering by boat on this appealing half-day tour. Only a short coach ride from the pier will see you reach Agios Ioannis, from where a local kind of boat known as a caïque will take you on a sun-kissed sail around the islands southern coastline. Feel the breeze in your hair and soak up the views as you pass Ornos, Psarou, Platis Gialos, Paranga and Super Paradise beaches some of the best on the island. Depending on the weather, swimming stops are also scheduled in the vicinity of selected beaches, so its worth having your swimwear on under your clothes. A chance to go ashore at Paradise beach and enjoy the facilities also forms part of the outing, as do delicious cold Greek snacks on board the caïque as you make your way home. Please note: the tour runs from June to September, but is available only for guests on board MSC Poesia. Guests are recommended to wear swimwear under clothes and to bring a hat, sunscreen and towels. The tour is not available for guests with mobility problems or using a wheelchair. Beach stops are not scheduled (with the exception of a stop at Paradise beach), but swimming will be possible directly from the caïque.

MYK12 - ISLAND TOUR AND TIME AT THE BEACH

A chance to explore the lovely Greek island of Mykonos and spend some time on a sunny beach awaits you on this appealing outing, which begins with a coach-based roundup of the islands best sights. After passing Ornos beach, you'll continue on to Agios Ioannis where you can catch views of Delos island in the distance. You'll ultimately be heading for the island's interior and the village of Ano Mera, home to the monastery and church of Panagia Tourliani. You'll visit the beautiful old complex built in the 16th, then remodelled in the 18th-century before making your way to one of the village tavernas for Greek appetizers with a shot of ouzo, the Greeks' national aniseed tippie, or a soft drink. Next up is the journey to the beach at Kalafati, where you'll then have about 2.5 hours to enjoy sun, sea and sand. The crystal-clear water is an open invitation to go swimming, the beach perfect for catching the sun or enjoying a walk along the shoreline. When the time comes, the coach will be waiting to return you to your ship. Please note: the price of the tour does not include use of sunbeds or umbrellas at the beach. However, they can be rented, subject to availability. Guests are recommended to wear swimwear under their clothes and to bring a hat, high-factor sunscreen and towels. **JTR01 - OIA VILLAGE**

CULTURE AND HISTORY



A short tender boat ride from the ship will take you to Athinios port where we will board a bus to Oia, a typical Greek village characterized by narrow streets, traditional white churches with blue domes a picture-postcard vision of the Mediterranean! This village is famous for its hill-top location which offers a breathtaking view over the Gulf of Santorini. Enjoy a 30-minute guided walk followed by approx. 45 minutes free time before boarding the coach and reach a nearby winery where delights of a different kind are in store. Sample local delicacies made of cheese, tomatoes, olives and bread accompanied by a delicious wine tasting session. Next on your list is a short visit of the village of Fira where, near the Metropolis Church, your guide will instruct you on how to take the cable car down the port of Thira. Once at the port, a boat ride takes you back to your ship. Please note: there may be long queues at the cable car station or to pick up the tender boat. As the ship stays at anchor, the transfer to and from the island takes place on tender boats. The tour includes walking on cobblestone streets with steps and is not suitable for guests with walking difficulties or using a wheelchair. The cable car ticket is included in the price of the tour.

Sail through the "Caldera", the Gulf of Santorini, to the tiny, uninhabited island of Nea Kameni. The island is home to a volcano which we will visit during a walking tour and which enriches the waters around the island. More islands are in store as we continue to Palea Kameni where our boat will anchor for about 30 minutes so you can swim from the boat in the warm, sulphuric waters. You then return to Skala port to board a tender boat back to your cruise ship. Please note: the excursion operates from June until the end of September and is subject to weather conditions. Depending on the boat's position, you might swim for a while in open sea to reach the hot springs. This tour is for guests who can swim and is not suitable for guests with walking difficulties, heart or asthma problems.

Your relaxing beach experience begins with a short trip on a tender boat to Athinios port, after which a coach will take you to Perivolos Beach, a picturesque stretch of sand giving onto the beautiful blue of the Aegean Sea. You will have some time to enjoy beach life and the various taverns, pubs and restaurants you will also find along the seafront. The rest of your trip will be spent sightseeing in Fira, the capital of the island of Santorini. You will be given instructions on how to reach the Metropolis Church and how to take the cable car back down to the port of Fira, where you will pick up your tender boat to return to the ship. Please note: the excursion operates from June until the end of September and is subject to weather conditions. The price of hiring sun loungers and parasols at the beach is not included in the price of the excursion. As the ship stays at anchor, the transfer to and from the island takes place on tender boats. There may be long queues at the cable car station or to board the tender boat. The tour is not suitable for guests using a wheelchair. The cable car ticket is included in the price of the tour.

JTR07 - OIA VILLAGE & BEACH

Blue skies and sunshine, breathtaking views and time to relax on a stunning beach make great reasons to join this leisurely tour of Santorini. After a short tender boat transfer to Athinios port, a coach will take you past Fira and the village of Imerovigli en route to Oia at the northern end of the island. Teetering on the crest of the volcanic caldera, the village affords glorious views of the bay and the Aegean Sea. A 30-minute guided walk is followed by some additional 30-minute free time for you to spend in Oia, exploring its pretty lanes, enjoying the blue and white of its Cycladic architecture, going shopping or stopping for a rest at one of the enticing cafés. Moving on, you'll then head south to the striking black-pebble beach at Perivolos. Served by a varied infrastructure, the tranquil beach surroundings are perfect for doing whatever you like. Your approx. 3.5-hour stay will include a complimentary umbrella and sunbed as well as free snacks and drinks served exclusively for you at a nearby beach-front café. But facilities for windsurfing, jet-skiing and scuba diving are also available, the cost of which is not covered by the price of the tour. Next, you will reach Athinios port where a motorboat awaits to take you back to the ship. Please note: there may be long queues to pick up the tender boat. As the ship stays at anchor, the transfer to and from the island takes place on tender boats. This tour includes walking on cobblestone streets with steps so is not suitable for guests with walking difficulties or using a wheelchair. The excursion operates from June until the end of September, is subject to weather conditions. 1 sunbed per adult available.

JTR05 - BEST OF SANTORINI

CULTURE AND HISTORY



Exciting, exclusive, edifying: three attributes that not only aptly describe this tour, but also the Greek island of Santorini itself, which was created when the crater left by a huge volcanic eruption collapsed, leaving only the rim, a so-called caldera. After a short boat ride to Athinios port, you will continue by coach to explore the island's history, capital and dramatic landscape. First up is ancient Akrotiri, a town that flourished during the Minoan Bronze Age, but then fell victim to a major volcanic outbreak that covered it ash in the middle of the 2nd millennium B.C.. Since excavation work began in 1967, many extremely well preserved artefacts have been uncovered, including frescoes and even some three-storey buildings. You will have about 1.15 hours to enjoy this prehistoric site before you move on to Fira, Santorini's capital, for more free time to spend as you please. The pretty lanes are fun to walk down, the cafés great for a pit-stop and the views of the Kamenis, twin volcanic islets in the bay, spectacular. Last up is Oia, a blue-and-white village in Cycladic style perched on the very edge of the caldera. After a guided walk through its pretty cobbled streets, a stop at a local winery will give you a chance sample local delicacies made of cheese, tomatoes, olivers and bread accompanied by a delicious wine tasting session. Next, board your coach to reach Athinios port where a motorboat awaits to take you back to the ship. Please note: as this tour involves walking on cobbled streets with steps, it is unsuitable for guests with mobility problems or using a wheelchair. As the ship stays at anchor, the transfer to and from the island takes place on tender boats. For all MSC Sinfonia calls and for MSC Opera calls, the tour will be performed in 6.5 hours. There may be some queues at the parking area to take the bus to the port and to embark on the motorboat back to the ship.

JTR08 - 4X4 ADVENTURE IN SANTORINI

ACTIVE & ADVENTURE



Join us on this excursion combining fun, adventure and Santorini's wild landscapes enabling you to spend a few hours exploring this lovely island in a completely different way. A short tender boat ride from the ship will take you to Athinios port where we board a bus to the location where your 4x4 jeeps await you. Board the vehicle and start your adventure driving to Akrotiri, located on the southern end of the island, an amazing lunar landscape created by the last eruption of the volcano. You'll then drive to Vlihada beach, where you will have a short break to jump in the cool waters of the Aegean Sea or to simply enjoy the views. The natural beauty of this secluded beach, framed by pumice stone hills, will enchant you. Next destination is the traditional village of Pyrgos for an opportunity to taste typical Greek snack at a local restaurant. Continue to the mountain of Profitis Elias, the highest of the island (550 m) with an incredible panoramic view of Santorini; be certain to have your camera ready for your memory book. Then take a road drive passing by the villages of Exo Gonia, Kamari and Monolithos. Your final destination will be the capital of the island, Fira. Here you'll have free time to stroll through the city and admire the beautiful views of the caldera before taking the cable car down to the port of Fira to return by tender boat to the ship. Please note: the tour is self-drive only; guests wishing to drive must be 21 years old, be in possession of a valid international driving licence, which they must have held for at least two years. Each 4x4 can accommodate a maximum of 4 guests, incl. the driver. If you travel with your family or friends, we cannot guarantee you will be in the same 4x4, depending on the available space as all vehicles must be occupied for its entire capacity. Moreover, only 1 guest per 4x4 will drive the vehicle. The tour is considered to be unsuitable for pregnant women, guests with back/neck problems or using a wheelchair. Vehicles all feature a manual gearbox; the driver must know how to operate a manual gearbox and be capable of starting the vehicle on an incline. Guests must sign a waiver before taking part in the tour. Periods of driving will not be narrated, but information will be given at the various stops by your guide. No changing facilities or showers are available on the beach. All vehicles are fully insured with a Collision Damage Waiver (CDW), excess according to the vehiclerental contract's terms and conditions. As the ship stays at anchor, the transfer to and from the island takes place on tender boats. The cable car ticket is included in the price of the tour. There may be long queues at the cable car station or to pick up the tender boat.

Your archaeological tour begins with a drive towards Pompeii, a once thriving town that was completely buried by lava, rubble and ash during the catastrophic eruption of Vesuvius in A.D. 79. It then lay hidden and perfectly preserved under tonnes of volcanic ash for almost 1,700 years before being accidentally rediscovered in the mid-18th century and then subsequently being excavated. The many artefacts that were found, especially items of daily life such as bread and honey, give the visitor a glimpse of the lives these ancient Romans lived. A fascinating guided walking tour will provide insight into the history of this amazing and very large archaeological site. A stop will also be made at a local coral factory on your return journey to the ship. Please note: as the tour involves longer periods of walking on uneven ground (i.e. boulders in the streets of Pompeii), it is considered to be unsuitable for guests of limited mobility or who use a wheelchair.
