GOA14T - DISCOVER GENOA BY SEGWAY®



Short but sweet, this entertaining tour takes you off the ship to discover the city of Genoa by Segway®, a great means of transport that's not only fun and very green, but also makes for leisurely urban exploration without having to get footsore in the process. Your guided roundup of Genoa's main sights takes you through the town's historical centre and includes views of the 13th- to 16th-century Doges' Palace, the birthplace of Christopher Columbus and Porta Soprana, the best known section of Genoa's remaining city walls. Your Segway® tour then rolls to a close with your return to the ship. Please note: this tour is only for guests who do not embark/disembark in Genoa port; it is not suitable for guests with mobility problems, pregnant women and those whose weight is less than 45 kilos or more than 117 kilos. The minimum age required to drive the Segway® is 16 years old; all guests aged 6/15 can participate in this excursion but will share the Segway® with an adult on condition the guests' total weight does not exceed 117 kilos. Guests have to sign a release act in order to take part in the tour. Assistance throughout the tour only in English and Italian. SCENIC ROUTE

Thanks to its illustrious past and collection of ornate buildings, Genoa also goes by the name of "La Superba" Italian for "The Proud One" and it is this civic beauty you'll be exploring on this leisurely sightseeing tour. Your guided coach tour begins at the port and takes you past such historical buildings as Columbus' birthplace and the 13th-century Palazzo San Giorgio, then continues down the seafront Corso Italia to reach the picturesque Boccadasse district. You'll have some free time to spend in this pretty harbour, flanked by the colourful houses of the resident fishing folk. When you move on again, you'll pass through the residential neighbourhood of Albaro and catch glimpses of Piazza Tommaseo and Piazza Vittoria as you head for the historical Piazza de Ferrari, Genoa's main square. Another break is scheduled here for you to explore on your own, with possible areas of interest being the old town and San Lorenzo Cathedral or a look at the Palazzo Ducale, the Doge's Palace. Last up on the itinerary is a drive up Castelletto Hill for splendid views from the observation deck, a perfect spot to take some photos. Please note: this tour is only for guests who do not embark/disembark in Genoa port and is not suitable for guests using a wheelchair.

GOA19T - BEHIND THE SCENES AT THE AQUARIUM

NATURAL WONDERS



Leave the ship for a few hours and instead check yourself in to a thoroughly educational and family-friendly outing for a behind-the-scenes look at Italy's largest aquarium, the Acquario di Genova. Built to coincide with the Genoa Expo in 1992, which in turn commemorated the 500th anniversary of the New World being discovered by Columbus, the aquarium is home to a vast collection of marine wildlife. After a short ferry transfer to the old part of Genoa and the Acquario, you and your family can first enjoy an unguided visit of the various tanks that provide a habitat for tropical fish, sharks, natural coral, penguins and dolphins. At a prearranged time, you'll then proceed on an expertly guided "behind-the-scenes" tour of the facility, during which you'll get to see the on-site laboratories, maintenance and plankton farming activities as well as how the animals are cared for and reared. And among the tank backstage areas, highlights include the jellyfish and dolphin enclosures. Your time at the Expo site wraps up with a little more time to explore on your own before the boat returns you to the ship. Please note: this tour is only for guests who do not embark/disembark in Genoa port. No guided visit inside the Aquarium except for the behind the scenes part; only cameras without a flash allowed. Guides available only in English and Italian. This tour is considered to be unsuitable for guests using a wheelchair.

**MRS02 - AIX-EN-PROVENCE**

CITY TOUR



We will leave Marseille port for a 40-minute drive to the lovely town of Aix-en-Provence. The excursion starts with a visit to the famous XII century St. Saviour's Cathedral and gardens. The Cathedral was built on the site of a Roman Temple and dates from a period that spans the XI and XIII centuries. Fronted by a richly decorated Gothic-style portal with elaborately carved doors, the Cathedral is flanked on the north by an unfinished tower. Enjoy a pleasant walk (1.5 hours) through the historic town centre before reaching the famous Mazarino Quarter, a residential district created by Cardinal Mazarin's brother in the last half of the XVII century for the gentry of Aix en Provence. Free time for shopping. Please note: this tour includes long periods of walking on uneven ground and is considered to be unsuitable for guests using a wheelchair. Guests of limited mobility are requested to evaluate their personal level of stamina and ability before taking part. Guests are requested to wear appropriate attire for religious visits. On 2-day calls, this tour may be performed also at night with a departure set at 16.30. It may be dusk while visiting some of the sites.

Formerly a quiet fishing village on the southern coastline of France near Marseille, Cassis has grown into a charming small town and popular international tourist resort. The town is particularly famed for its cliffs, calanques steep-walled inlets and the local white and rosé wines. On leaving the port of Marseille, your tour begins with a 1-hour coach transfer, followed by a local train to the town. Once there, you will have plenty of time to stroll on your own around Cassis' charming streets, lined with the brightly coloured homes of the locals, and beautiful port as well as enjoy splendid views afforded from the waterfront. Your tour ends with your return trip back to the ship. Please note: the starting place of the local tourist train may be crowded so please expect some queues. The little tourist train is available from May through middle September; for any call before May or after September, guests will walk to the city centre from the coach parking lot (approx. 500 mt.). This tour is not available from October until February inclusive.

Join us on a visit around this important maritime town. We will begin our excursion with a visit to the Basilica of Notre Dame de la Garde which stands majestically on top of a hill. The Basilica is made up of a lower and an upper church and was built on the site of an ancient chapel. Continue along the "Corniche" (coast road) where we will admire Borely Castle and garden (no inside visit). The excursion includes sightseeing in the centre of Marseilles and photos at Longchamps Palace before enjoying some free time in the "Vieux Port" (old port). Please note: this tour includes walking uphill with some steps around the Basilica and is not available to guests who use a wheelchair; guests of limited mobility are requested to evaluate their personal level of stamina and ability before taking part. Guests are requested to wear appropriate attire for religious visits. The visit to the Basilica of Notre Dame de la Garde may be replaced with a visit to Marseilles Cathedral in case of special events. On 2-day calls, this tour may be performed also at night with a departure set at 16.00. It may be dusk while visiting some of the sites.

**MRS14 - DELUXE VISIT TO PROVENCE: AVIGNON & AIX-EN-PROVENCE**

CULTURE AND HISTORY

While the sun-kissed shores of southern France make ideal holiday destinations, the delightful towns lying inland are equally worth a visit. Designed to let you savour two such jewels, the outing begins with a 40-minute drive to Aix-en-Provence, where you will visit the Cathedral of the Holy Saviour. Sitting on the site of a former Roman forum and amalgamating a variety of architectural styles from the 5th- to the 17th-centuries, the Cathedral boasts a richly decorated Gothic façade with elaborately carved doors, and to the north of the building an unfinished tower. You will then walk through the historical district to reach the lovely Mazarin quarter, a residential area built for the town's gentry in the second half of the 17th-century. A chance to relax then follows on the 90-minute drive up to Avignon, after which you'll have some time for lunch in one of the town's many brasseries before moving on to the monumental Papal Palace, the seat of Christianity in the 14th-century and now a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Rich in galleries and chapels as well as frescoes and hand-painted wall-hangings in the private papal suite, the palace still bears testament to its former opulence. The pleasant return drive to Marseille and your ship then brings the tour to an unhurried close. Please note: this tour includes long periods of walking on uneven ground with stairs to negotiate; it is not available to guests who use a wheelchair. Guests of limited mobility are requested to evaluate their personal level of stamina and ability before taking part. Guests are requested to wear appropriate attire for religious visits. The cost of lunch (optional) is not included in the price of the tour.

Spend 2 hours off the ship stretching your legs in the fresh air on a leisurely walk around the lovely French city of Marseille, situated in the nation's deep south. You'll catch a shuttle bus to reach the city centre, after which the tour continues on foot. Taking through a mainly pedestrianised area, the guided walk begins at the foot of the old town and ends at its highest point, with information provided on the city's storied past as you go. Key landmarks include the 17th-century city hall, 16th-century Hôtel de Cabre, the magnificent Cathedral of Saint Mary Major, completed in the late 19th-century, and Fort Saint-Jean, built in 1660 by order of Louis XIV. You'll also have some free time to explore the Vieux Port the old harbour area before catching a shuttle bus back to the ship. Please note: This tour includes approximately 1.5 hours of moderate walking, at times over uneven surfaces is not available to guests who use a wheelchair. MAL16 - MÁLAGA & THE PICASSO CONNECTION

CULTURE AND HISTORY



Sitting pretty on the Costa del Sol, the bustling city of Málaga is up for exploration on this appealing half-day sightseeing tour. Prepare to board a shuttle to reach the city centre and then, accompanied by your friendly guide, set off on a 30-minute walk that will acquaint you with the artistic legacy left by Picasso. You'll first cross Plaza de la Marina - Málaga's main square - en route to Plaza de la Merced and the house in which Picasso was born. Today, the building serves the purpose of showcasing the great man's life and works. Following this first introduction to the world of Picasso at the Museo Casa Natal (Birthplace Museum), a 15-minute walk will take you to the nearby Picasso Museum, which is housed in the 16th-century Buenavista Palace. Explore the museum and feel inspired by the many paintings, sculptures, drawings, ceramics and graphics created by Picasso throughout his life. After the visit, you'll have some free time to spend in Málaga city centre before the shuttle returns you to your ship. Please note: Wheelchair users must be accompanied by a paying helper to provide assistance with getting on and off the coach; wheelchairs must be collapsible/foldable since the coach has neither a ramp nor a lift. Wheelchair users wishing to take part in this are requested to contact the Shore Excursions' Desk promptly once they are on board so that arrangements can be made. This tour is not available on Sundays and on Tuesdays afternoons.

CAD07 - WALKING TOUR OF CADIZ

This guided tour starts near the port in the "Plaza de España" and takes in the "Plaza de la Mina", the outside of the Museum of Cadiz and "Calle Ancha" where we will stop and admire the XIX century palaces. We will also pass through the lovely walled "San Juan de Dios" Square, located close to the sea and with a magnificent marble fountain. Continue to the Town Hall and Cathedral for exterior visit. You will have some free time to stroll the city before returning to the port. The tour then continues on foot to Barrio de Santa Cruz, Seville's Jewish quarter, which is characterised by its quaint, narrow streets and typical local patios. Next up is a stop at the Alcázar, an ancient medieval fortress built by Moorish craftsmen. It was once a residence of the Spanish royal family and is now a UNESCO world heritage site. The last leg of the tour takes you to Maria Luisa's Park and the Plaza de España, which is surrounded by luxurious pavilions that date back to the Latin-American exposition of 1929. To ensure you keep your strength up, the tour includes a delicious lunch. Please note: if it is not possible to visit the Alcazar or the Cathedral, you will visit Pilato's House; have the program reconfirmed during your cruise. The tour includes walking on uneven ground at the "Barrio de Santa Cruz" and there are many steps inside the Cathedral therefore is not suitable for guests with walking difficulties or using a wheelchair. Conservative attire recommended for visiting sites of religious importance. The visit to the Alcazar will not take place on 26.09.2019 (MSC Orchestra); the duration of the tour on this date will be 7 hours.

Depart from the pier and, passing over 25th April Bridge, sister bridge of the Golden Gate, you will drive to the base of the Statue of "Christ the King", from where magnificent views of Lisbon can be seen. Our excursion continues in the town of Azeitao, renowned for its famous pastries and for the "Moscatel de Setubal" wine. We will visit a local wine lodge for wine tasting session and to learn more about how this sweet aperitif wine is produced. Next, we will proceed towards the "Parque Natural da Arrabida" National Park that was established to protect the wild, beautiful landscape and rich variety of birds and wildlife found here. The road winds across the mountain ridge and offers stunning views of Setúbal and Tróia. Return to Lisbon to enjoy a sightseeing tour and then reach "Rossio" where we will stop for a little time at leisure. Return to the port. Please note: this tour includes long transfers by coach. This tour offers a great opportunity to explore Lisbon, Portugal's capital city, from a unique perspective: on board one of its wonderful, old-fashioned trams, which are not only used by scores of commuters on a daily basis, but have also become a real tourist attraction. After leaving your ship, a short coach ride will first take you from the pier to Martim Moniz Square, from where you will catch your tram. Once on board, you will be served a local speciality known as "pastel de nata" (a succulent little custard tart) along with a glass of porto wine to further sweeten your ride up to the hills of Lisbon. You will have a glimpse of the old part of Lisbon, passing Graça quarter and Alfama district. You will reach Portas do Sol belvedere, with enchanting views of the metropolis and the Tagus river and pass by the Cathedral towards downtown of Lisbon and the elegant Baixa district. Look forward to an exterior viewing of Jerónimo's Monastery as well as the Belém Tower on the banks of the River Tagus, both of which are fine examples of Manueline architectural style (also called late Portuguese Gothic) and both of which were declared UNESCO World Heritage Sites. Your tour comes to a close with your return to the port and your ship. Please note: this tour is considered to be unsuitable for guests with walking difficulties or in a wheelchair. Due to parking restrictions in force in Belém Tower area, the photo stop at the site is not guaranteed; if the stop cannot take place, guests will be able to take pictures of Belém Tower from the coach.

Care to explore the great city of Lisbon in a manner less ordinary? Then join this tour and prepare to spend a few hours traversing land and sea in a vehicle that will chime with your inner 007: an amphibious craft! You'll board the ingenious hybrid the first of its kind on the Iberian Peninsula at the pier, after which you can enjoy the land-based leg with views of key landmarks such as Praça do Comércio, Praça do Rossio, Liberty Avenue and Marquês de Pombal Square. A stop is scheduled in the Bélem quarter for you to try a "pastel de Bélem", a tasty Portuguese custard tart, and take an outside look at Jerónimos Monastery, whose construction was completed in 1601. During the tour, your guide will share interesting facts about the many myths, legends and curiosities that lie hidden among the streets of Lisbon. And then it will be time to take the plunge for a nearly 30-minute trip along the River Tagus, during which you can soak up great views of Lisbon's skyline from a waterside perspective. Once back at the pier, your outing draws to a close with your return to the ship. Please note: as entering/exiting the amphibious vehicle involves negotiating 5 large steps, the tour is considered to be unsuitable for guests using a wheelchair. The tour runs with an English- or Portuguese-speaking guides only.

This half-day beach getaway is perfect for the entire family to enjoy and begins with a sightseeing drive around some of Lisbon's key landmarks. You'll pass the impressive Monument of the Discoveries - a romanticised celebration of Portugal's Age of Discovery in the 15th and 16th centuries - in the civil parish of Santa Maria de Belém on the northern bank of the River Tagus. After crossing to the southern bank of the river, you'll head for one of the best beaches in the Lisbon area: Costa da Caparica. You'll have plenty of time to savour the beachy vibe at this popular spot, going swimming, eating ice cream, building sandcastles - the choice is entirely yours. The outing lastly ends with your return to the ship. Please note: the tour is subject to weather conditions and may be cancelled to suit. Due to the fact that the Portuguese school summer holidays run from the 2nd half of June until the end of July, guests are advised that there will be lots of children at the beach.
