**WAR02D - BERLIN SIGHTSEEING ENDING AT THE AIRPORT**

CITY TOUR



Promising to deliver the best of Berlin, this all-day tour begins with a scenic 3-hour coach drive through northern Germany to meet your guide in the big city. The tour will then take you to Charlottenburg Palace, a vast complex in Baroque-/Rococo-style that dates back to the late 17th-/early 18th-centuries. After a chance to take some photos, you will move on through the west of Berlin, driving down Kurfürstendamm, then passing the 19th-century Kaiser Wilhelm Memorial Church and the KaDeWe, Germany's largest department store. As you head for East Berlin, the route will take you past the 19th-century Victory Column and Potsdamer Platz before you will have 1 hour free time to explore the area around the Brandenburg Gate or to have lunch on your own. During the communist era, this was the site of the terrifying "death strip", but now freed of this oppressive spectre, the area welcomes visitors with the German Reichstag building on the one and the lovely Unter den Linden boulevard on the other side. Re-connect with your guide at the nearby Holocaust Memorial before heading for East Berlin, passing Bebelplatz, Gendarmenmarkt, Checkpoint Charlie an iconic reminder of the former political division and Alexanderplatz with its imposing TV tower. The excursion will also give you chance to take a look at what is left of the Berlin Wall before heading back to Berlin airport. Please note: limited number of guides in languages other than German. Should a tour guide for your language be unavailable, the tour will be in German only. This tour ends at Berlin Tegel airport for guests who are and booked on flights after 18:00 hours. The duration of the tour also includes the time for the transfer to the airport. **WAR07 - WARNEMÜNDE ON FOOT**

CITY TOUR

Situated at the mouth of the River Warnow and founded in the year 1195, the Baltic resort of Warnemünde presents visitors with an appealingly quaint townscape one that this tour gives you a chance to explore on foot. After leaving the ship and meeting your guide, you'll set off on a roughly 2-hour walk around town. The route will take you down the promenade alongside the Alter Strom literally Old Stream harbour entrance, complete with moored fishing boats and yachts, old houses that fishing folk call home, cafés and a lighthouse dating back to 1897. Your guide will provide you with interesting information on the history of the lovely old town as you stroll towards the a building simply called the Kurhaus the spa building which was built in Art Deco style and completed in 1928 according to plans already drawn up in 1898. Once you've returned to the Alter Strom, you can choose whether to stay and do some shopping or whether to return straight to the ship. Please note: This tour is only for guests who do not embark/disembark in Warnemünde port. This tour includes approximately 2 hours of moderate walking, at times over uneven surfaces. The tour is not available to guests who use a wheelchair; guests of limited mobility are requested to evaluate their personal level of stamina and ability before taking part. #### TAL14 - THE GOTHIC TREASURES OF TALLINN

CULTURE AND HISTORY



Our tour begins with a circuit around the old town where we will briefly view the medieval city wall. We will stop at Tall Hermann Tower for an external view of the imposing castle before setting off for a guided walk through the winding streets of this old Hanseatic town, with external viewing of the Transfiguration Church and the old merchants' houses. Admire the impressive Renaissance façade of the Blackheads Brotherhood House, the well-preserved Gothic Guild House and the quaint Holy Ghost Church with the oldest street clock in Tallinn. Enter the XV century Town Hall for a guided tour of this magnificent building. Walk through the Dominican convent to view St. Catherine's passage and see the oldest pharmacy in Europe that has been in operation since 1422. Then, time to shop for souvenirs comes next. We will quickly see the Viru Gate in the city wall before boarding the bus back to the pier. Please note: this tour is not suitable for guests using a wheelchair; there are 15 steep steps to reach the Town Hall. Guests of limited mobility are requested to evaluate their personal level of stamina and ability before taking part. Only cameras without a flash are allowed inside the Town Hall.

HSK01 - INTRODUCTION TO HELSINKI

Leave the ship and get set to explore Helsinki also known as the "White City of the North" due to the pale local granite of which numerous buildings are made and enjoy some of its many delights. **Wednesday 1 October 2025****RIG01 - INTRODUCTION TO RIGA**

CITY TOUR

This enjoyable sightseeing tour will introduce you to the lovely city of Riga, the capital of Latvia. The tour includes calls at the Orthodox Cathedral, the Freedom Monument and the building of the Fine Art Museum. After reaching the old part of the town, you will continue on foot to Theatre Square, with a short stop to go shopping and buy souvenirs or just stroll around and enjoy the cityscape. The tour then continues on to the town hall square and past St. Peter's Church, St. George's Church and St. John's Church. A certain highlight of the tour is the brief recital of organ music at Riga's Dome Cathedral. You will also have a chance to see the outside of the Swedish Gates and Riga Castle. Be sure to take your camera so as to capture the undeniable beauty of the city's historical centre, which was declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site particularly because of its unparalleled art nouveau architecture. The tour concludes by returning you to port and your ship. Please note: limited number of guides in languages other than English. Should a tour guide for your language be unavailable, the tour will be in English only. Guests need to negotiate 15 steps to enter the Dome Cathedral. This tour is almost entirely performed on foot, at times over uneven surfaces and is not available to guests who use a wheelchair. Guests of limited mobility are requested to evaluate their personal level of stamina and ability before taking part. Guests are requested to wear appropriate attire for religious visits.

### RIG09 - RIGA FROM ANOTHER PERSPECTIVE

CITY TOUR

This excursion starts with a panoramic coach tour through the streets of Riga. Admire the fine medieval and wooden buildings and beautiful examples of the Art Nouveau style, as well as the city's more modern architecture. The panoramic tour ends by Basteja Hill, where you board a wooden boat for the next leg of your excursion. Now see Riga from a different viewpoint the city's canals. The National Opera, Central Market and National Theatre are just a few examples of sights you will see during the 1-hour boat trip. Your guide will be happy to dedicate plenty of time to answering your questions, as the group in each boat is small. The final leg of the excursion is a walking tour in the Old Town. Over the following 90 minutes, you will see all the highlights of the Old Town, while your guide tells you local stories. ### KLJ01 - KLAIPEDA OLD TOWN & PALANGA AMBER MUSEUM

CULTURE AND HISTORY



Amber, a kind of fossilised tree resin, is much admired as a gemstone for its mellow golden glow and since the Baltic is known for its extraction industry, this tour teams a look at Klaipeda's old town with a visit to the Amber Museum in Palanga. Your walk around the old town begins at theatre square to see Ännchen von Tharau, a statue commemorating a folk ballad written by Klaipeda-born poet Simon Dach. As you pass the timber-frame houses of the old town, you'll also have a chance to browse market stalls selling handicrafts and amber jewellery before you move on to Palanga. You'll be visiting both the Palanga Botanical Gardens, created more than 100 years ago, and the co-located Amber Museum, housed in the 19th-century Tikeviciai Palace. The museum provides information on where Baltic Gold can be found, its uses and its characteristic inclusions history captured in beads of resin. You'll then have time to explore Palanga's promenade, which ends the Baltic Sea and features numerous cafés, bars, restaurants and souvenir stalls, or visit the 19th-century Neo-Gothic church, after which you'll return to the ship. Please note: the number of guides in languages other than English is limited. Should a tour guide for your language be unavailable, the tour will be in English only. This tour is not suitable for guests using a wheelchair; there are 8 steps to negotiate to enter the Amber Museum. Moreover, the excursion includes walking on cobblestone streets in Klaipeda old town. Guests can choose to remain in Klaipeda old town, about 800 m (875 yds.) from the ship, after the end of the tour; maps can be provided.

### KLJ02 - KLAIPEDA & THE MYSTERIOUS HILL OF WITCHES

NATURAL WONDERS

The beautiful port of Klaipeda lies opposite the northernmost tip of the Curonian Spit, a narrow belt of land separating the Curonian Lagoon from the Baltic Sea. A coach ride and ferry crossing will first take you to the spit, after which you'll make your way to the seaside resort of Juodkrante. Once a part of Old Prussia and then called by the German name of Schwarzort (Black Place), Juodkrante boasts numerous beautiful 19th-century buildings that go to make up its special charm and is also home to Amber Bay, the site of amber extraction since the 19th century. And while modern sculptures can be found adorning the shoreline of the lagoon, a set of rather mystical pieces can be found at the Hill of Witches, which you'll visit. The open-air gallery boasts around 80 large wood carvings, spread out on a forested sand dune, that go to bring Lithuanian folk tales to life. You'll then move on for a look at the Dead Dunes, so named for several villages that were taken by the sands, before you return to Klaipeda. Please note: the number of guides in languages other than English is limited. Should a tour guide for your language be unavailable, the tour will be in English only. This tour includes walking for a total of 8km so it is not suitable for guests with walking difficulties or using a wheelchair.

**KLJ06 - A TRIP BACK TO COLD WAR**

CULTURE AND HISTORY



The former Soviet missile base in the middle of the Plokting Forest, part of the emaitija National Park about an hours drive from the port, closed its doors in 1979 and has since reopened as a grim reminder of the Cold War years that followed WWII. Built under the cloak of secrecy in 1960, the site went live in 1963 with four silos housing R 12 missiles pointed at Berlin, London, Madrid and Paris. It was also the site from which the missiles were deployed that sparked the Cuban Missile Crisis in 1962. The underground Soviet control centre and the silos are now open for inspection, as the first site of its kind, and you'll have a chance to go on a guided tour of its grisly corridors and tunnels, accessed via a mine shaft reaching 27 m (30 yards) into the ground. You can also see the inside of one of the silos by climbing through its narrow hatch a unique opportunity. As a contrast to the sober theme of the visit, your return journey will be one of glorious views, delivered by the beautifully clear waters of Lake Plateliai and its three lovely islands. Please note: the number of guides in languages other than English is limited. Should a tour guide for your language be unavailable, the tour will be in English only. This tour includes approx. 40 steps to negotiate, walking underground and visit very narrow and small rooms, so it is not suitable for guests with walking difficulties, using a wheelchair or who suffer from claustrophobia. Guests can choose to remain in Klaipėdas old town, about 800 m (875 yds.) from the ship, after the end of the tour; maps can be provided.

**KLJ07 - HIKING IN DUNES PARADISE**

Slip into a pair of comfy walking shoes, hop on a coach and then take a 10-minute ferry to reach the Curonian Spit, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Separating the Curonian Lagoon from the Baltic Sea, this narrow strand of land boasts a stunning landscape of pine forests and dunes, including the 8-km (5-mile) stretch of the Nagliai Nature Reserve, noted for the intricate windblown patterns of its dunes. You will hike through this unique and eerie landscape, under which several villages including four iterations of Nagliai itself lie buried beneath the sands. A drive south will then see you reach Juodkrantė, the spits oldest fishing village and a bustling summer resort. After a look at the late 19th-century Lutheran church, the weathervane gallery, enjoy a walk along the sculpture-decorated shoreline. Back in Klaipėda, you will visit theatre square to hear the ballad of "Ännchen von Tharau" and browse the amber market before taking a break for Lithuanian beer, fried bread and smoked cheese at a local restaurant. The tour concludes with your return to the ship. Please note: the number of guides in languages other than English is limited. Should a tour guide for your language be unavailable, the tour will be in English only. Guests can choose to remain in Klaipėda's old town, about 800 m (875 yds.) from the ship, after the end of the tour; maps can be provided. This is not suitable for guests with walking difficulties or using a wheelchair.

**KLJ03 - THE WEST OF LITHUANIA BY COACH AND BOAT**

Minija is also the gateway to Lake Krokė Lanka (Krokai), a shallow saltwater lake that an abundance of waterfowl calls home. Leaving the lake, you will then head back to Minija with more views of the spit and the lagoon to enjoy on your way back to the ship. Please note: the number of guides in languages other than English is limited. Should a tour guide for your language be unavailable, the tour will be in English only. Wheelchair users must be accompanied by a paying helper to provide assistance with getting on and off the coach; wheelchairs must be collapsible/foldable since the coach has neither a ramp nor a lift.
